

**ENVISION CINEMA CONSERVATORY
SENIOR PROJECT**

Requirements:

- Produce a 5-minute narrative short film
- Film topic must be approved by Brad and Andrew
- Film content must meet regular ECC standards for school film projects and screening (related to foul language, violence, etc.)
- A script must be approved by Brad and Andrew
- A rough cut must be screened during Conservatory
- A final cut must be approved by Brad and Andrew before public screening
- Seniors must work together to plan, organize, publicize, and host a free screening of the senior films; screening may take place on campus or off-campus at a public location
- Film must be submitted to the *CCA Film Festival*, the *All American High School Film Festival*, and at least one other festival through FilmFreeway or something similar

Production & Class Attendance

- Seniors may work individually or with a senior partner
- 2nd and 3rd year Conservatory seniors will not be involved with underclassmen narrative project production during the Senior Project timeline; 1st year Conservatory seniors may choose to complete a Senior Project or work on underclassmen narrative project
- Seniors are required to check in with Brad for attendance every Conservatory day
- Seniors may leave campus to work on their project after the attendance check-in daily, with an off-campus driving form on file with Brad
- Seniors are required to attend the entire Conservatory class for the following underclassmen activities: Script read through, Rough Edit and Final Edit underclassmen project critique days, and any special activity days (e.g. guest speaker)

Project Rubric (500 points total)

Film Topic/Treatment (Due March 26)	50 points
Script (Due April 3)	50 points
Rough Cut (Due on or before May 1)	100 points
Final Cut (Approved before Senior Screening)	150 points
Screening Organization/Participation (On or before May 31)	150 points

***Location must be determined 30 days before event**
