PROJECT OVERVIEW

Students will create their first short movie by filming different camera angles and editing each of them together with music. Students will focus on learning the basics of working with the video camera equipment along with editing in Adobe Premiere Pro through this project. Though students will work in groups when using the equipment, each student will be responsible for making their own individual video project.

The main goal of the montage video assignment is to allow students to familiarize themselves with the basic principles of the Video Film Class, which include but are not limited to: 1) working hands on with the camera equipment and editing software technology, 2) collaborating together in groups similar to a professional creative work environment and 3) learning to communicate their personal interests involved with the artistic expression process.

PROJECT GUIDELINES

- 1-2 minute film
- The story of the film should focus on creatively capturing the day of a student at school.
- Film should feature at least 10 different shot types/camera angles discussed in class.
- Film must include basic movie elements such as: title, transitions, music, and credits.
- Video should be created for an audience at CCA, including parents, teachers, and administrators
- Students must post the film along with a short reflection of the process on their portfolio
- Students must finish each step of the Project Rubric before moving onto the next part of the project. Otherwise, their work will be considered incomplete for the project.
