MOVIE CRITIQUE

Write a one-page, typed, double-spaced (12 point font) critical review of the movie, making sure to answer the following questions as well as any other aspects of the movie you would like to critique. This critique should be written like a movie review you would find on-line, in the newspaper, or in a magazine. It should be written in essay/paragraph form WITHOUT a list of numbers.

1. Who was your favorite character in the movie and why?
2. Describe your favorite scene and explain what made it a quality scene in your opinion.
3. What visual aspects of the movie were especially appealing?
4. What about the movie did you not like and why?
5. If you were directing this movie, what would you have done differently?
6. Were there any examples of product placement in this film? If so, what were they? Did it make sense or was it a distraction from the story?
7. Often when we watch a movie, television show, or play, we have to suspend disbelief to enjoy the production, because the action goes beyond the boundaries of what you think could really happen. This is a semi-conscious decision in which you put aside your beliefs and accept the premise as being real for the duration of the story. Did you have to suspend disbelief while watching this movie? If so, how or why?
8. Would you recommend this movie to a friend? Why or why not?
