

## SEQUEL COMPARISON

### VIDEO/FILM

Watch an original movie and its sequel. Address the following questions in a one-page essay comparing the films. You should consider yourself a movie reviewer writing for a newspaper, magazine, or on-line publication and include the answers to the following questions as part of this one-page essay. (Paper specifications -- 1-page, double-spaced, typed, 12 point, Times Roman font, standard Word margins.)

1. Which movie is better the original or the sequel? Explain why.
2. Did the original movie deserve a sequel? Why or Why not?
3. What is distinctly different about the two movies? What do the two movies have in common?
4. How does the sequel move the original story forward?
5. Are there any major changes in the sequel, as far as different actors playing a character or any other changes not in-line with the original?
6. How would you improve the movie you liked the least?
7. What was visually appealing about either or both films?
8. What would you have done differently in the movies if you were the director?
