

THE REMAKE PROJECT

Video/Film Class

This video assignment is your first “feature” film. For this film you will be working in groups with your classmates to recreate a scene from a popular film (or possibly a fictional television show).

Process:

1. Each group picks a movie scene (PG-13, PG, or G only) of their choice to remake. Keep in mind -- the scene must be created here at school and needs to be **3-5 minutes** in length. You will be trying to recreate every shot as closely as possible: the setting, lighting, costumes, camera angles, actions, dialogue, and content. The content of the scene must also be school appropriate and approved by Mr. Raines.
2. Before recording the scene, you will participate in the entire pre-production process, which includes four major elements: the Treatment, the Script, Storyboards, and a Call Sheet.
3. Groups will then film their scene somewhere on campus, with a proper Location Agreement approved by Mr. Raines and appropriate school personnel.
4. The scene will then be edited in the Video/Film classroom.
